Introductory Remarks of the *Statistics of the Catholic Church in Korea*

The Catholic Bishops' Conference of Korea publishes the *Statistics of the Catholic Church in Korea* annually on the basis of the data collected by December 31 of the year.

The General Secretariate of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Korea sends a formula to 16 dioceses and a different formula to all religious and missionary institutes in Korea in November of the year, and asks them to return the filled formula to the Secretariate till the end of February of the following year.

The *Statistics* are made on the basis of a complete enumeration survey targeted at all Catholics in Korea and of a distribution survey which asks to fill a certain formula distributed.

The General Secretariate of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of Korea collects 100 percent of data from each diocese and religious and missionary institute by fax, mail and e-mail, and after a verification process and count, publishes the *Statistics of the Catholic Church in Korea*.
